This has the reference of this office letter no 7-1/ANCOL/Admission/2021-2022/513 dated 16/09/2021 and 7-1/ANCOL/Admission/2021-2022/515 dated 17/09/2021 and to place a Corrigendum as stated below:

The eligibility conditions for engaging Resources Person may be read as under.

1. Eligibility For Humanities and Social Sciences

- a) A Masters Degree with 55% marks (or and equivalent grade in a point - scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an indian university, or and equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- b) Besides fulfilling the above qualification, the candidates must have cleared the national eligibility test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CISR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC or who are or have been Awarded a Ph.D Degree in accordance with the university grants commission (minimum standards and procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.degree)regulations 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET.

2. Eligibility for Performing Art (BPA-Hindustani Vocal and Instrumentations)

- a) A Masters Degree with 55% marks (or and equivalent grade in a point - scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an indian university, or and equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- b) Besides fulfilling the above qualification, the candidates must have cleared the national eligibility test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CISR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC or who are or have been Awarded a Ph.D Degree in accordance with the university grants commission (minimum standards and procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.degree) regulations 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET.

A traditional or a professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the subject concerned having a Bachelor's Degree, who has:

- 1) Studied under a noted/reputed traditional Master(s)/Artist(s).
- 2) Has been 'A' grade artist of AIR/Doordarshan
- 3) Has the ability to explain, with logically reasoning the subject concerned; and
- 4) Has adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in the disciplin concerned.

The candidate those who are having above qualifications in concerned/relevant/allied subject can apply on or before 29/09/2021 in the prescribed proforma already published in the ANCOL website.
